### About Destination:

**Shimla** is the capital of the northern Indian state of Himachal Pradesh, in the Himalayan foothills. It's also known for the handicraft shops that line The Mall, a pedestrian avenue, as well as the Lakkar Bazaar, a market specializing in wooden toys and crafts. **Manali** is a hill station nestled in the mountains of the [Indian state of Himachal Pradesh](#) near the northern end of the [Kullu Valley](#), at an altitude of 2,050 m (6,726 ft) in the [Beas River Valley](#). It is located in the [Kullu](#) district. Manali is named after the lawgiver [Manu](#). **Dharamshala** is a city in the upper reaches of the Kangra Valley and is surrounded by dense coniferous forest consisting mainly of stately Deodar cedar trees. It is the district headquarters. It was formerly known as Bhagsu. **Dalhousie** is a hill station in Chamba district in the northern state of Himachal Pradesh, India. It is situated on 5 hills and has an elevation of 2,400 meters above sea level. **Chandigarh** is the best-planned city in India, with architecture which is world-renowned, and a quality of life, which is unparalleled. The city got its name from a temple "Chandi Mandir" located near the city. "Chandi" is the deity – the goddess of power; "garh" means dwelling place, which translates into "dwelling place of the goddess Chandi."

DAY	DETAILS
Day 1	<p><b>New Delhi - Shimla (350 Kms, 08 Hours)</b></p> <p>Arrive Delhi airport / railway station and drive to Shimla the former summer capital of British India, set amidst the snow capped Shivalik Mountains which offers some of the most stunning views of the mighty Himalayas. Enroute visit Pinjore Gardens or Ropeway at Timber Trail, Parwanoo. Arrive and check into the hotel. Evening free to stroll on The Mall and the famous Ridge. Ridge is famous for its stunning vistas of the valley and the Christ Church which is the most photographed landmark of Shimla.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Shimla. ( _ _ D)</b></p>
Day 2	<p><b>Shimla</b></p> <p>After Breakfast Excursion to Kufri. Kufri is famous for its Himalayan National Park, Poney and Yak Ride and One can see the endless Himalayan Panorama from Kufri, after lunch sightseeing of various places in and around. Shimla mosques built in(1830), Vice regal Lodge built in (1885), Christ Church built in (1844), The Gaiety Theatre- the first beauty contest of world was supposed to start (1887), The Grindlays Bank (1912)- the world wide bank started by Robert Melville Grindlay, The Scandal Point and The famous Shopping Plaza of the North The Mall.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Shimla. ( _ _ D)</b></p>
Day 3	<p><b>Shimla to Manali (265 Kms, 8 Hours)</b></p> <p>Depart from Shimla to Manali by surface Enroute visit Kullu valley, Beas River, Dashehra maidan etc. Arrive and transfer to hotel Manali. Evening free for rest.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Manali. ( B _ D)</b></p>
Day 4	<p><b>Manali (Local Sightseeing)</b></p> <p>Morning proceed to Visit the 450 years old Hidimbadevi Temple, the oldest temple in Manali, Tibetan center &amp; monastery, Vasisth village, known for its hot Sulpher springs Roerich art Gallery. Bahist Temple, Solang Valley which offers a spectacular view of glaciers and snow capped peaks. At an altitude of 3978 meters. Also visit Kothi, Rahala Water falls on the way. (Subject to weather conditions and road being open). Rest of the day is at leisure or takes a stroll down the Mall road.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Manali. ( B _ D)</b></p>

<b>Day 5</b>	<p><b>Manali - Rohtang Pass - Manali (51 kms, 2 hours)</b></p> <p>Early morning visit A place not to be missed – Rohtang Pass, from Manali at an altitude of 3978 meters. Also visit Kothi, Rahala Water falls on the way. (Subject to weather conditions and road being open). Rest of the day is at leisure or takes a stroll down the Mall road.(Visit to Rohtang Pass not included in the cost. Subject to weather conditions and road being open).(As per Himachal Government Rouling outsiders not go to do the Rohtang Pass &amp; Guest Have to Take Car from union on Direct Payment Basis. ).</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Manali. ( B _ D)</b></p>
<b>Day 6</b>	<p><b>Manali to Dharmshala (280 Kms, 10 Hours)</b></p> <p>Depart towards dharmshala on the way visit to Baijnath known for its Shiva Temple and further at Palampur famous For Tea Garden. Dharamhsala is a hill-station lying on the spur of the Dhauladhar Mountains about 18 kms north-east of Kangra, It is known for its scenic beauty set amidst high pine and oak trees. Since 1960, when it became the temporary headquarters of His Holiness The Dalai Lama, Dharamshala has risen to international repute as “The Little Lhasa in India”.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Dharmashala. ( B _ D)</b></p>
<b>Day 7</b>	<p><b>Dharmshala to Dalhousie (145 Kms, 5 Hours)</b></p> <p>After Breakfast drive from Dharamshala towards Dalhousie after doing the local sightseeing of Places which includes, His holiness Dalai lama residence at McLeodganj, War memorial, Bhagsunath temple and Dal Lake. Reach Dalhousie in the evening.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Dalhousie. ( B _ D)</b></p>
<b>Day 8</b>	<p><b>Dalhousie - Khajjiar ( 24 kms, 30 Min )</b></p> <p>Dalhousie has been named after the British Governor – General of the 19th century, Lord Dalhousie. Surrounded by varied vegetation – pines, doddies, oaks and flowering rhododendron. Local sightseeing of Dalhousie includes visit to Panjipula, Subhash Baoli and excursion to Khajjiar 24 Kms. from Dalhousie surrounded by thick Deodar forest. Drive from Dalhousie to Khajjiar is awesome.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Dalhousie. ( B _ D)</b></p>
<b>Day 9</b>	<p><b>Dalhousie - Chandigarh (350 kms, 9 Hours)</b></p> <p>Depart from Dalhousie to Chandigarh.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Chandigarh. ( B _ D)</b></p>
<b>Day 10</b>	<p><b>Chandigarh</b></p> <p>After B/F check out hotel. Visit Rose Garden, Rock Garden, Lake. Enjoy the day in Chandigarh.</p> <p><b>Overnight in the Chandigarh. ( B _ D)</b></p>
<b>Day 11</b>	<p><b>Chandigarh to Delhi (250 Kms, 6 Hours)</b></p> <p>After B/F check out from hotel. Depart for Delhi. On arrival drop at Railway Station/ Airport.</p>
